Have you seen painters scraping and priming on the front of the church? Nowhere near the top of the steeple, they still appear small against the meetinghouse. Their task seems daunting. To us, the task of raising funds to preserve this building is equally daunting, but we have made visible progress.

The enclosed financial update shows that we are just under \$10,000 short of our fundraising goal, with about \$5,000 needed in pledges, and a matching \$5,000 challenge grant hanging in the balance. So we ask again for your financial support—with gratitude for all you have done already.

If you have pledged, please do meet, accelerate, or increase your support, as you are able. Your timely gift is important as we schedule the work to match our anticipated receipts. If you have not yet pledged or contributed, please join us as stewards of this brick meetinghouse, now entrusted to our care.

Each dollar from members of the congregation has been matched by \$2.80 from other sources. This is a testament to the significance that others ascribe to the building. And some don't even consider what has occurred inside its walls: the celebrations of communion, of marriage, of baptism, and of lives well-lived, for over 188 years since the South Church of Newport was dedicated.
